

# New win at Brussels City

**Thanks to the new payroll-system Capgemini and HR Access will roll out for Brussels City, the salary processing of around 6.000 employees will go much smoother and much more efficient in the future. The project started 21st February 2008 and will be closed at the end of 2008.**

Starting now, Brussels City disposes of a payroll-system with which the salary processing runs much faster: is used to be a couple of hours, now at most 15 minutes. The user friendly and modular system will in time also permit to process time registration data automatically.

The total value of this contract amounts to 800.000 EUR. On this project, four Capgemini consultants will work together with GIAL, which takes care of the IT-management of Brussels City.
